- July 20 Day at leisure. Evening parade into Hjørring Stadium, official opening ceremony and Dana Cup disco.
- July 21 Start of tournament with group matches.
Evening: Dana Cup team managers and coaches meeting.
- July 22 First round group matches.

- July 23 Second round play-off matches.

Sport program included:

Sweden: Participation in the Gothia Cup.

Denmark: Participation in the Dana Cup.

Accommodation and meals included:

Sweden: School accommodation in schools in Gothenburg.

- Daily breakfast, lunch and dinner included. First meal: Evening dinner Sunday, July 12, and last meal lunch on Saturday, July 18.
- Each team will receive one classroom for its own use. The Gothia Cup will arrange bedding for all participants. Bedding includes a mattress on the floor with pillow, sheets and a duvet/blanket. Schools have shared facilities and bathrooms by gender.



Denmark: Accommodation in schools in Hjørring or Tornby (7 miles from Hjørring).

- Daily breakfast, lunch and dinner included. First meal: Evening dinner Monday, July 20 and last meal lunch on Saturday, July 25. For the days before Monday and after Saturday you can order extra meals; CAD \$14.00 for breakfast, CAD \$17.00 for lunch and CAD \$19.00 for dinner.
- Each team will receive one classroom for its own use. The Dana Cup will arrange bedding for all participants. Bedding includes a cot, mattress, blanket, pillow and linen. Schools have shared facilities and bathrooms by gender.

Ground transportation included:

During the Gothia Cup and Dana Cup the tournament organizers arrange special shuttle transportation. On free days we can arrange a private chartered bus for excursions (for an additional charge).

Local guide services included:

During your stay at both tournaments, you can collect information or address any questions or concerns with the local tournament staff, which is readily available.

Options available (not included in prices)

Accommodation options Gothia Cup:

Option 1: Hotel accommodation in a nice hotel in Moeldal, 5-10 minutes from Gothenburg.

- Rooms for 2-4 people all with private bathroom, TV, mini bar, telephone, data port, trouser/skirt press and ironing board and iron. The hotel has a lounge, bar, conference rooms and a fitness center with Jacuzzi and sauna.
- Supplement per person per night sharing a quadruple room CAD \$22.00. Supplement per person per night sharing a triple room CAD \$30.00. Supplement per person per night sharing a double room CAD \$54.00.

Option 2: Hotel accommodation at the Gothia Towers, a 4-star hotel in the center of Gothenburg.

- Double and triple rooms all with private bathroom, TV, telephone, parquet floor, mini bar, iron, trouser press, a kettle for tea and coffee and a safe deposit box. The hotel has a lounge, bar and various restaurants.
- Supplement per person per night sharing a triple room CAD \$48.00. Supplement per person per night sharing a double room CAD \$75.00.

Both hotel options include breakfast daily only. The Gothia Cup offers a meal plan as well; self-service, cafeteria type meals served at the schools. Costs are approx. CAD \$162.00 per person for 12 meals and CAD \$88.00 per person for 6 meals (lunch or dinner).

Please notice that we can guarantee the hotel names only when the entire group books a hotel stay. If your team will stay at the schools, parents will be accommodated in similar hotels but not necessarily in these specific hotels. In addition to this, if parents stay at hotels and players/coaches at the school airport transfers are only included for the players/coaches. Parents can take a taxi from the airport to their hotel.

Accommodation options Dana Cup:

Option 1: If your group decides on the school accommodation for the players and chaperones, we can offer parents and family members accommodation in a nearby hotel. Rooms with private bathroom and daily breakfast included. Supplement per person per night is CAD \$96.00 sharing a room for 2 people or CAD \$218.00 per night for a single room.

Option 2: The Dana Cup offers accommodation in apartments as well.

- This apartment complex is located in Hirtshals, directly at the beach and 8 miles from Hjørring.
- All apartments have a living room, kitchen and one, two or three bedrooms.
- The complex offers a lounge, restaurant, indoor and outdoor swimming pool, table tennis, sauna, solarium, laundry room, etc.
- Accommodation is only available from Saturday to Saturday so if your group decides to book this option, travel dates need to be adjusted.
- Supplement per person per stay CAD \$364.00 for 6 people sharing an apartment. Supplement per person per stay CAD \$431.00 for 4 people sharing an apartment. Supplement per person per stay CAD \$723.00 for 2 people sharing an apartment.
- You can order your own meals through the apartment complex (CAD \$15.00 breakfast, CAD \$11.00 box lunch and CAD \$22.00 dinner) or order them through the Dana Cup (cafeteria type meals – to be served at the Dana Cup center – CAD \$189.00 for a meal package; 3 meals a day from Monday dinner until Saturday lunch).

(These prices always include the special Dana Cup package including the special Dana Cup shuttle transportation (accommodation to fields and vice versa), free admission to the Hjørring swimming pool, Hjørring museums and Dana Cup disco as well as discounted admission at Farup Summerland and the North Sea Museum).

Travel insurance option:

We offer your travelers the option to purchase travel insurance. More information about the travel insurance, including rates and policy details, will be sent after the tour booking.

Not included in prices:

- Beverages (soda) with meals.
- Gratuities for representatives and bus drivers.
- Admission fees to attractions.
- Single rooms in hotels. Single rooms are available at a supplement of CAD \$54.00 per person per night on top of the double room supplements outlined in the accommodation description.

GOTHIA CUP - GOTHENBURG/SWEDEN

The opening ceremony at Ullevi Stadium attracts 50,000 spectators and participants, while 1,500 volunteers guarantee that this will remain the tournament of all tournaments! First-class competition on first-class fields is only part of this great festive week. Located on Sweden's beautiful west coast, Gothenburg offers all the excitement of a major seaport city, as well as fine beaches, water sports, boat trips, shopping and dining. The 2020 Gothia Cup will again be the world's largest and most prestigious soccer party for both players and fans.

Gothia Cup facts:

- 1,600+ international youth soccer teams
- 40,000 participants from 80 different countries
- One of the highlights of the tournament is the Olympic style opening ceremony which takes place in Ullevi Stadium, home stadium of Swedish pro club IFK Göteborg, with 50,000+ spectators.

DANA CUP - HJØRRING/DENMARK



Come and meet the rest of the world at the Dana Cup 2020, the World's most international youth soccer tournament with 90% foreign teams. More than 1,000 teams from 45 nations each summer. They come to play international soccer, but also because of the fantastic international atmosphere. The Dana Cup is a sporting challenge mixed with a cultural experience where young soccer players regardless of borders, skin color, politics and religion can meet in a safe environment. Each year the tournament is proud to welcome the rest of the soccer world to Hjørring

Dana Cup facts:

- 1,000+ international youth soccer teams.
- Over 45 different countries represented.
- Tournament co-organized by Fortuna Hjørring, one of the top professional clubs in Denmark.

Touristic information:

- Beaches: many miles of excellent sandy beaches on the North Sea coast near Hirtshals, approx. 15 kms from Hjørring.
- North Sea Oceanarium: situated in Hirtshals. This centre also has Europe's largest sea-aquarium. Furthermore, there is a sea-lion basin and a Maritime-, a fishing- and a sea-biological museum.
- Frederikshavn: (36,000 inhabitants). One of Denmark's most important ferry-ports and marine base. There are various museums and from here Gothenburg/Sweden can be reached for a day-trip using one of the most modern ferry-vessels in the world. Cruising at approx. 70 kms per hours the journey can be covered in about 2 hrs.

How to book and payment conditions:

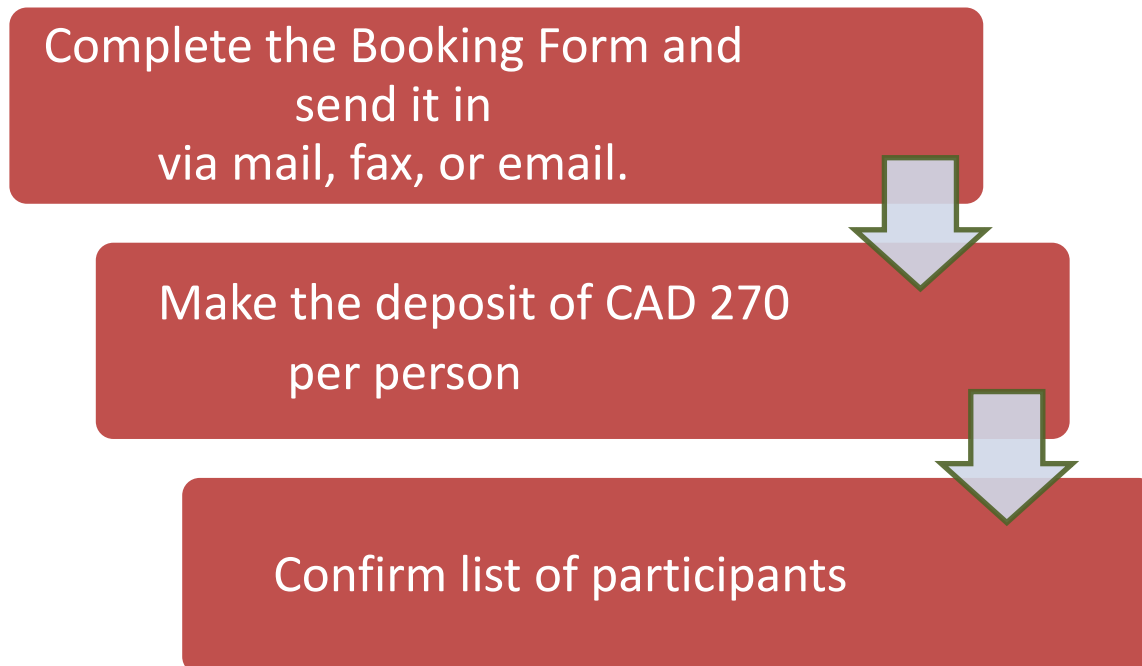
1. Contact us with any questions, concerns, or changes to the itinerary/tour proposal.
2. Share and discuss the tour proposal with your group and set a date to get commitments for the tour.
3. Set a date to collect deposits to commit to the tour. We require a non-refundable CAD 200.00 deposit per person to book the tour – see below for more information about payments.
4. Once you have deposits and are ready to book the tour, fill out the Booking Form (document sent in the same e-mail as this proposal) and send it back to us along with the group's deposit (see below for more information about payments and this information is also included on your group's website page).
5. We will have a page on our website specifically for your group with your group's tour information, our General Conditions, payment information, fundraising, deadlines, a tour preparation guide and more. This website link has been e-mailed to your coach/team manager to share with the group.

Additional information about payments:

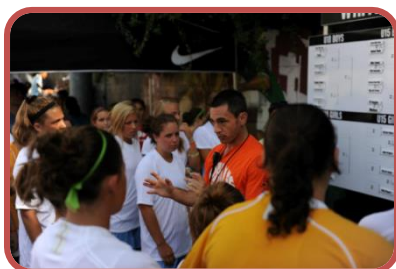
