Ireland – Dublin, Galway and Limerick

Travel dates:

July 6-15, 2020

Itinerary:

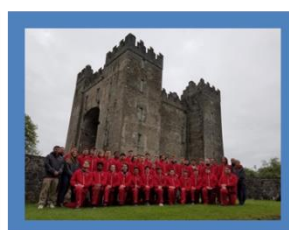
- July 6 Departure from Washington-Dulles airport.
- July 7 Arrival Dublin airport. Transfer to your accommodation. Time permitting, optional stop at Aviva Stadium, home stadium of the Irish National Team. Rest of day/evening at leisure.
- July 8 Sightseeing Dublin – visit and tour Trinity College, Dublin Castle, Christ Church Cathedral, and St. Patrick's Cathedral. Evening game vs. local team.
- July 9 Sightseeing Dublin: Options include visit the Kilmainham Gaol tour, one of the largest unoccupied gaols (jail) in Europe, covering some of the most heroic and tragic events in Ireland's emergence as a modern nation from 1780s to the 1920s, and/or visit the Guinness Storehouse and Old Jameson Distillery tour. You can take the train into Dublin for sightseeing on this day.
- July 10 Day at leisure for more sightseeing in Dublin. You can take the train into Dublin on this day for sightseeing.
- July 11 Transfer to your accommodation in Galway. Check in to hotel and rest of day/evening at leisure.
- July 12 Day free for sightseeing and exploring Galway. Stroll along High Street taking in all its shops, restaurants and typical Irish pubs. Evening game vs. a local team.
- July 13 Transfer to Limerick. On way make a stop of Cliffs Moher and take in the spectacular views of the Irish coastline.
- July 14 Sightseeing in or around Limerick. Options include: visit Blarney Castle and kiss the Blarney Stone, the legendary Stone of Eloquence, found at the top of the castle tower, and/or take a tour King John's Castle, or Make an excursion to Bunratty Castle and Folk Park where you can experience the living reconstruction of the homes and environment
- July 15 Transfer to Dublin airport and flight back home.



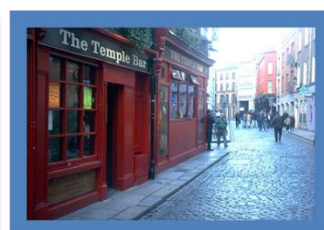

We will arrange a total of 3 games per team.

Accommodation and meals included:

Dublin: 3-star hotel accommodation in Dublin (Clayton Hotel Leopardstown or similar).

- Daily breakfast and dinner included.
- Hotel located in the south of Dublin within a short driving distance to the center of Dublin. Hotel is located within short walking distance to the train station with 20-minute train access to the center of Dublin.
- Accommodation in triple rooms (3 people per room) all with private bathroom, iron, safe, coffee maker, satellite TV and phone.
- The hotel has a pub, coffee/pastry shop, restaurant and free Wi-Fi.
- Double and single rooms available as well at a supplement. Supplement for a double room (2 people per room) is \$15.00 per person per night.

Galway: 3-star hotel accommodation in Galway at the entrance of the city (Connacht Hotel Galway or similar).

- Daily breakfast and dinner included.
- Hotel located right at the city center entrance off of Main Dublin road. There is a bus stop right outside of the hotel with quick access to all of Galway including to High Street where there are several shops, restaurants and pubs.
- Participant prices based on accommodation in triple rooms (3 people per room) all with private bathroom, iron, safe, coffee maker, satellite TV and phone.
- The hotel has a pub, coffee/pastry shop, restaurant and free Wi-Fi.
- Double/twin and single rooms available as well at a supplemental cost. Supplement for a double/twin room (2 people per room) is \$15.00 per person per night.

Limerick: 3-star hotel accommodation in Limerick.

- Daily breakfast and dinner included.
- Hotel located in Limerick within a 5-10 minute drive from the city center.
- Participant prices based on accommodation in triple rooms (3 people per room) all with private bathroom, iron, safe, coffee maker, satellite TV and phone.
- The hotel has a restaurant, bar/lounge, gym and indoor swimming pool.
- Double/twin and single rooms available as well at a supplemental cost. Supplement for a double/twin room (2 people per room) is \$10.00 per person per night.

Transportation:

During your stay, the group will have a private bus available exclusively for your group 10 hours a day each day with the exception of 2 days while in Dublin. On the days in Dublin you don't have the bus you can take the train (within walking distance of the hotel) into Dublin for sightseeing.

Local guide services:

A local tour manager will be assigned to be exclusively with your group full time each day during your stay to provide any assistance when necessary, and help plan or amend your daily schedule as needed.

Options available (not included in prices)

Travel insurance option:

We can offer your group participants comprehensive travel insurance which includes accident, illness and trip cancellation coverage – more information will be sent to you after booking. Approx. costs for this travel insurance is \$67.00 - \$195.00+ depending on the age of the participant and the tour price.

Other items not included in prices:

- Beverages (soda) with meals.
- Gratuities for representatives and bus drivers.
- Admission fees to attractions. This applies to per person admission fees for sights and attractions.
- Single rooms in hotels. Single rooms are available at a supplement of \$40.00 per person per night on top of the double room supplements outlined in the accommodation description.

Touristic Information Dublin

Dublin is the capital and largest city of Ireland. Dublin is in the province of Leinster on Ireland's east coast, at the mouth of the River Liffey. Founded as a Viking settlement, the Kingdom of Dublin became Ireland's principal city following the Norman invasion. The city expanded rapidly from the 17th century and was briefly the second largest city in the British Empire before the Acts of Union in 1800. Following the partition of Ireland in 1922, Dublin became the capital of the Irish Free State, later renamed Ireland.

Guinness Brewery:

Guinness Storehouse is one of the most popular tourist attractions in Dublin, at St. James's Gate Brewery. Since opening in 2000, it has received over four million visitors. The Storehouse covers seven floors surrounding a glass atrium shaped in the form of a pint of Guinness. The ground floor introduces the beer's four ingredients, and the brewery's founder, Arthur Guinness. Other floors feature the history of Guinness advertising and include an interactive exhibit on responsible drinking. The seventh floor houses the Gravity Bar with views of Dublin and where visitors may drink a pint of Guinness included in the price of admission.

St. Patrick's Cathedral:

Saint Patrick's Cathedral in Dublin, Ireland, founded in 1191, is the National Cathedral of the Church of Ireland. With its 141 ft tall spire, St. Patrick's is the tallest church in Ireland and the largest. Christ Church Cathedral, also a Church of Ireland cathedral in Dublin, is designated as the local Cathedral of the diocese of Dublin and Glendalough.

Aviva Stadium:

The spectacular Aviva Stadium is home to the Republic of Ireland National Soccer Team. It is Ireland's only UEFA Elite Stadium and has played host to matches for large tournaments such as the Heineken Cup, Nations Cup, and European Cup.

Downtown Dublin:

The Downtown area is home to several shopping centers, restaurants, pubs, and historical buildings. For shopping, visit Grafton street, Dawson street, located only a few blocks from Trinity College, or O'Connell and Henry street located near The Spire. The Spire otherwise known as the Monument of Light, is a 390 ft tall monument that has become a favored tourist location in Dublin. For fine dining try the Brasserie sixty6 or Dax Restaurant, just two of many top-rated restaurants in Dublin. The Rustic Stone just a few blocks from Grafton Street offers a unique and modern Irish food options.

Dublin Castle:

Erected in the early thirteenth century on the site of a Viking settlement, Dublin Castle served for centuries as the headquarters of English, and later British, administration in Ireland. In 1922, following Ireland's independence, Dublin Castle was handed over to the new Irish government. It is now a major government complex and a key tourist attraction. We hope you enjoy your visit.

Touristic Information Galway

Galway, known as the City of the Tribes, is an important tourist center and a gateway to the scenic areas of the county. Beginning in the 15th century, Galway was ruled by the leading fourteen merchant families, which were known as "tribes." The families built many castles throughout County Galway. Many streets and landmarks bear the names of these early "tribes."

Galway is a bustling town with fantastic nightlife. The beautiful scenery, charming pedestrianized streets, and numerous pubs and cafes are sure to keep you occupied.

Cliffs of Moher:

A must-do while on your way to Galway, is to see the awe-inspiring Cliffs of Moher. Here you will encounter nature in its wildest, purest form – see the rugged cliffs facing the mighty ocean, taste the salt air, feel the ancient rocks beneath your feet. This destination is one of the most breathtaking sights to see during your trip to Ireland.

Eyre Square/City Center:

While in Galway, the City Center there is plenty to see and do. The Eyre Square Center is home to several shops, restaurants, pubs and tourist attractions.

Limerick:

While in Limerick visit King John's Castle, a 13th century marvel located next to the River Shannon.

Bunratty Castle:

The site on which Bunratty Castle stands was in origin a Viking trading camp in 970. The present structure is the last of four castles to be built on the site. Bunratty Castle, is the most complete and authentic medieval castle in Ireland. Built in 1425 it was restored in 1954 to its former medieval splendor and now contains mainly 15th and 16th century furnishings, tapestries, and works of art which capture the mood of those times.

Folk Park:

Enjoy the sights, sounds tastes, scents, of this enchanting place as you stroll from house to house or around the charming village street complete with school, post office, doctors house, hardware shop, printers and of course McNamara's pub. When you visit Bunratty Folk Park you experience a living reconstruction of the homes and environment of Ireland of over a century ago. Set on 26 acres, the impressive park features over 30 buildings in a 'living' village and rural setting.

How to book and payment conditions:

3. Set a date to collect deposits to commit to the tour. We require a non-refundable US\$ 200.00 deposit per person to book the tour – see below for more information about payments.
4. Once you have deposits and are ready to book the tour, fill out the Booking Form (document sent in the same e-mail as this proposal) and send it back to us along with the group's deposit.

Additional information about payments:

Your group can make (bi) monthly payment installments to pay for the tour. The payment installments will be discussed between Premier International Tours and the group leader to ensure that the installments will work for all participants and overseas partners involved in the tour.

These installments can be made by credit card or by check. If any participant decides to pay by credit card we will make a customized credit card authorization form for your group which would then need to be filled out by your group participants and sent back to us. 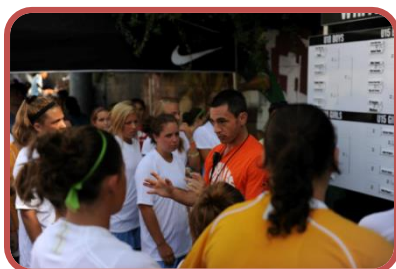
