Itinerary:			
January 8	Departure from Chicago-O'Hare airport.		
January 9	Arrival London or Manchester airport. Transfer to your accommodation in York.		
January 10	Morning training session with your own coaching staff. Suggested sights for this day are: Tour of Jorvik Viking Center, Clifford's Tower and York Arc (Archaeology Center).		
January 11	Possible afternoon or evening visit to a pro game. Sightseeing York. With a stunning cathedral (York Minster) and the world's best railway museum, York boasts major sights as well as smaller gems like medieval guildhalls, Georgian town houses & National Trust and English Heritage properties. Afternoon or evening game vs. a local team.		
January 12	Possible afternoon or evening visit to a pro game. More sightseeing York. Suggestions: Visit Castle Museum and Yorkshire Museum.		
January 13	Day free for additional sightseeing in York – York Dungeon and York Art Gallery and/or visit the National Railway Museum. Evening lecture with Jonathan Wilson, journalist, author and founder of the The Blizzard (lecture arranged by your group).		
January 14	Transfer to your accommodation in Liverpool. Along the way stop in Leeds to visit the Royal Armouries Museum in Leeds		
January 15	Sightseeing Liverpool. Suggestions: Visit Liverpool Cathedral, the Merseyside Maritime Museum and/or the International Slavery Museum. Evening game vs. a local team.		
January 16	More sightseeing Liverpool. Suggestions: visit the Museum of Liverpool including the Kicing and Screaming Football Show (film); then visit the Beatles Story and Cavern Club.		
January 17	Optional visit and tour Anfield, home stadium of Liverpool FC and then The Walker Art Gallery. Evening game vs. a local club.		
January 18	More sightseeing Liverpool. Suggestions: Visit the Liverpool Cathedral and Tower and the Tate (gallery) on Albert Dock. Possible afternoon or evening visit to a pro game.		
January 19	Transfer to your accommodation in Manchester. Possible afternoon or evening visit to a pro game.		
January 20	Optional tour of Old Trafford, home of Manchester United. Also visit the National Football Museum, England's museum of football (soccer).		
January 21	Sightseeing Manchester. Suggestion: Visit the People's History Museum and the Museum of Science and Industry.		
January 22	More sightseeing in Manchester. Suggestion: Visit the John Rylands Library and the Manchester Museum, Manchester Art Gallery, Albert Square and Manchester Town Hall. Evening game vs. a local team.		
January 23	Transfer to London or Manchester airport. Return flight.



Ground transportation included:

Bus transfers for airport transfers, game transfers and city transfers are included. The hotels are all within walking distance of a train station and some major sights.

Local guide services included:

A local tour assistant will be assigned to be exclusively with your group full time each day during your stay in each destination to provide you with any assistance when necessary and help plan or amend your daily schedule as needed.

Options available (not included in prices)

Sport program options:

- Visit and tour of a pro team stadium between \$25.00 and \$30.00 per person.
- We can arrange tickets to pro games, subject to availability. Ticket costs will depend on the game, but usually ticket costs range from approx. \$75-\$150 per person depending on the game.

Travel insurance option:

Accident, illness and trip cancellation/interruption insurance – more information will be sent to you after booking. Approx. costs for trip insurance is \$67.00 - \$195.00+ depending on the age of the participant and the trip price.

Not included in prices:

- Beverages (soda) with meals.
- Gratuities for representatives and bus drivers.
- Admission fees to attractions.
- Single rooms in hotels. Single rooms are available at a supplement of \$40.00 per person per night on top of the double room supplements outlined in the accommodation description.




How to book and payment conditions:

- 1. Contact us with any questions, concerns, or changes to the itinerary.
- 2. Share and discuss the itinerary proposal with your group and set a date to get commitments for the tour. Make sure to share the General Conditions Document Form (document sent in the same e-mail as this proposal) with the group as well so all participants understand the terms and conditions.
- 3. Set a date to collect deposits to commit to the tour. We require a non-refundable US\$ 200.00 deposit per person to book the tour see below for more information about payments.
- 4. Once you have deposits and are ready to book the tour, fill out the Booking Form (document sent in the same e-mail as this proposal) and send it back to us along with the group's deposit.
- 5. Check our <u>Travel Prep Guide</u> on our website for more information on international travel and steps to prepare your group for the tour.

Additional information about payments:

Your group can make (bi) monthly payment installments to pay for the tour. The payment installments will be discussed between Premier International Tours and the group leader to ensure that the installments will work for all participants and overseas partners involved in the tour.

These installments can be made by credit card or by check. If any participant decides to pay by credit card we will make a customized credit card authorization form for your group which would then need to be filled out by your group participants and sent back to us. We will keep this form on file for each installment. If the participant decides that he/she would like to pay by check the check will need to be sent in the mail a week before the installment is due to ensure that the payment is made on time. Include participant name(s) and group name on check.


